New support levels for asylum seekers on Section 95 for 2011-12 from 18 April.

The increase in support payments is 3.1% and in line with the increase in payments to those on Income Support. Asylum seekers have to live on less than 70% of Income support. Section 4 rates are currently being decided. The new Section 95 rates will be announced on 18 April.
